#### What is Southwest Airlines Aviation Day?

Aviation Day is an opportunity to educate and inspire  $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$  grade students about the aviation industry.

<u>APPLICATION:</u> This year we are taking up to 200 Campers, but selections will be made on a first come first served <u>basis.</u>

#### When can my student apply?

In 2017, the application will be open August 7 – August 18 or until the maximum capacity is reached.

#### Where will Aviation Day be hosted?

Aviation Day will be held at Southwest Airlines TOPS Building in Dallas, Texas. 2432 Wyman St, Dallas, TX 75235 (Activities may take place in multiple buildings, including HDQ, TOPS, and the hangar.)

# Does my child need to be a certain age to apply?

We are looking for students who are going into 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade.



#### Is there a cost associated with Aviation Day?

There will be no cost to attend the Aviation Day! Lunch will be provided to campers; however, they may bring money for additional food or beverage purchases throughout their day.

#### Are accommodations provided?

Campers and their parent/guardian (21 or older) will be responsible for their own accommodations during the camp.

# Will transportation be provided?

Campers and their parent/guardian are responsible for all transportation to and from Southwest TOPS Building. No transportation will be needed during the day at Aviation Day, as all activities will be taking place on campus.

# What will my child do at Aviation Day?

Campers will be participating in a variety of activities, including tours of our Hangar, the Network Operations Center, as well as a variety of hands-on activities during the day. They will also spend time learning how their skills and interests relate to Southwest careers.

## What is the dress code?

The dress code for the camp is casual. More information will be sent prior to Aviation Day if your child is selected.
